

March 2024 Update to Clubs

Contact Information in Event Catalogs

The Delegate body has approved changes to Chapter 12, Sections 1 and 4 of the <u>AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows</u> so that only the name, city, and state is required for the listing of judges, owners, and exhibitors in event catalogs. The street address is no longer required. This is effective for events held on or after July 3, 2024.

Complaints Against a Club or Person

The Delegate body has approved changes to Article XII, Section 1 of the <u>AKC</u> <u>Charter and Bylaws</u>. This section addresses complaints made against a person or club that are submitted to AKC. Changes were made to remove the requirement for a notarized statement to be included with the complaint and clarified that the decision to entertain the jurisdiction of a complaint is under the authority of the AKC Board of Directors. This is *NOT* a change to the process for filing complaints at an event. Specialties Held in Conjunction with All-Breed and Group Shows

All-breed and group clubs are actively seeking specialty clubs to collaborate with in hosting events. They frequently provide financial benefits to specialty clubs by lowering the expenses associated with supporting their specific breed. Using the Breed Filter When Searching for Conformation Events

When using the <u>AKC Event Search & Results</u> to search for Conformation events we highly recommend that you consider using the BREED filter.



When the BREED filter is used, the base information displayed in the event results will include information about the judge(s) at the event. Below is an example of the base information displayed for an event, one without a breed set and the other with the BREED filter set to German Shepherds:





Many exhibitors have found the BREED filter to be a very powerful feature when searching for future events.
